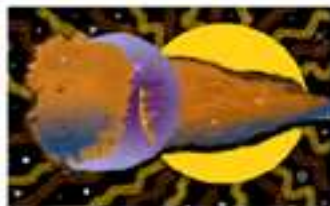
**Linda Blair:** Lead Actor

The specific purposes for which WorldHeart was organized are to teach and disseminate educational material related to safe and loving animal adoption, animal care, animal welfare, and the relation of these topics to individuals' personal welfare, including lifestyle and healthy, non-animal dietary choices, to the public, through publications, lectures, and other means, and by making grants and donations to other non-profit public benefit organizations having similar aims and objectives.
